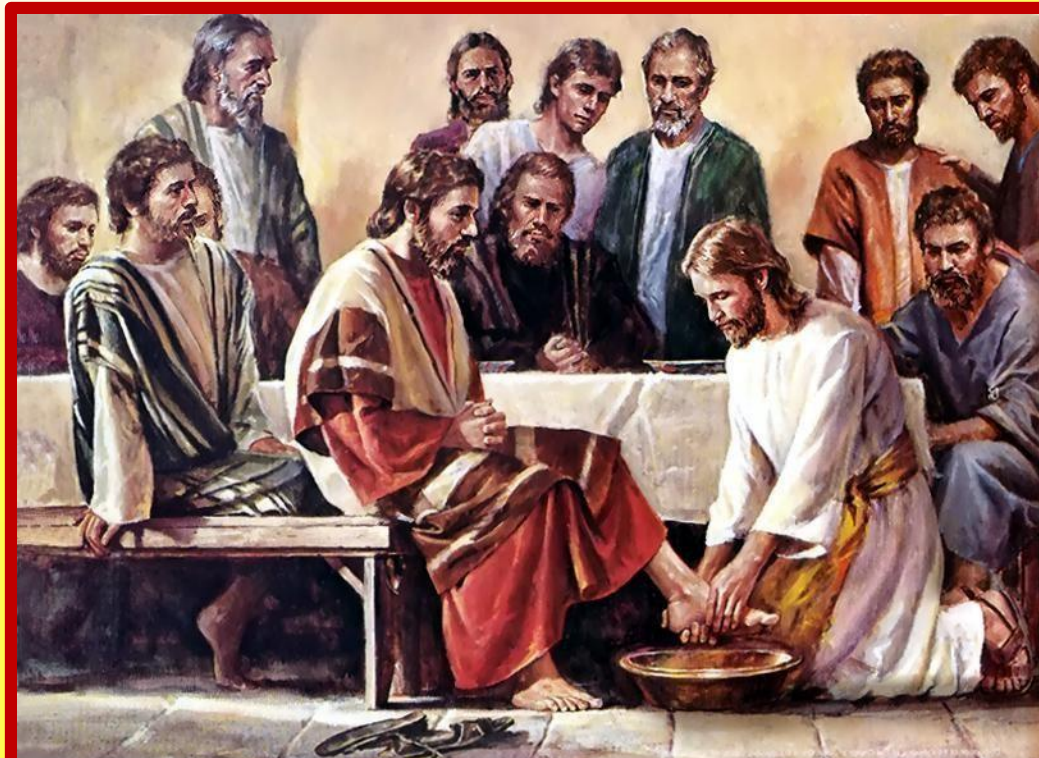

Jesus gave us the example of love and service by washing the feet of His disciples, He tell us:

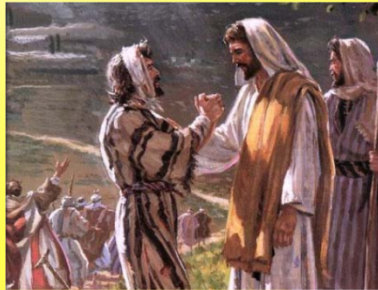
“Love one another as I have loved you”

Sign of the Cross.

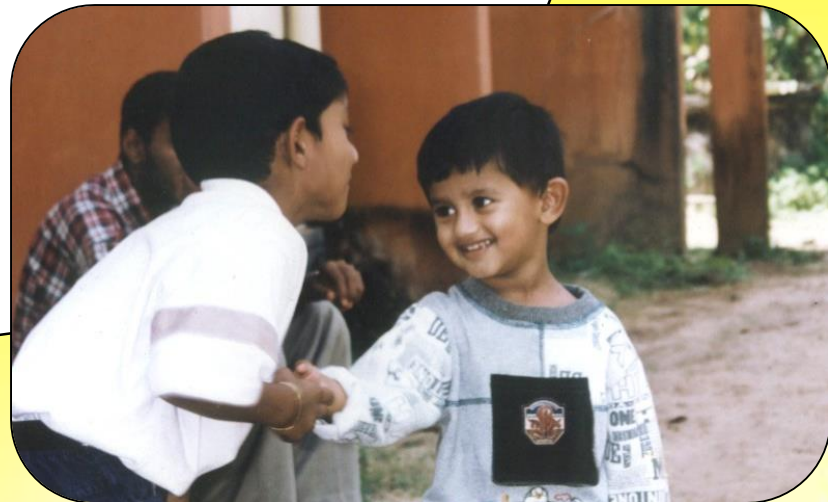
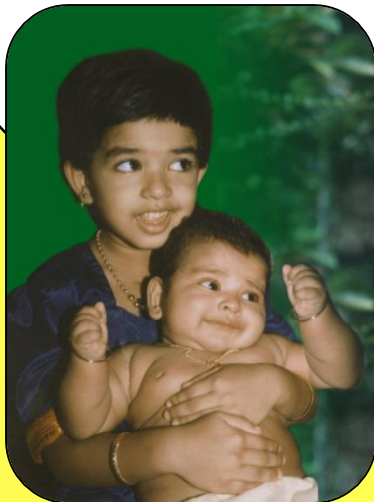
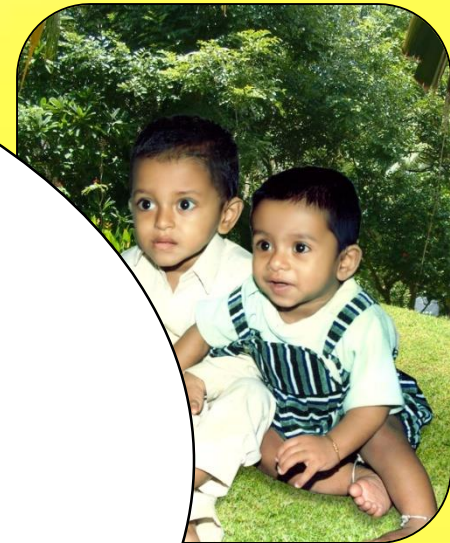
(Solemn form)

Dear Jesus, teach me to love everyone



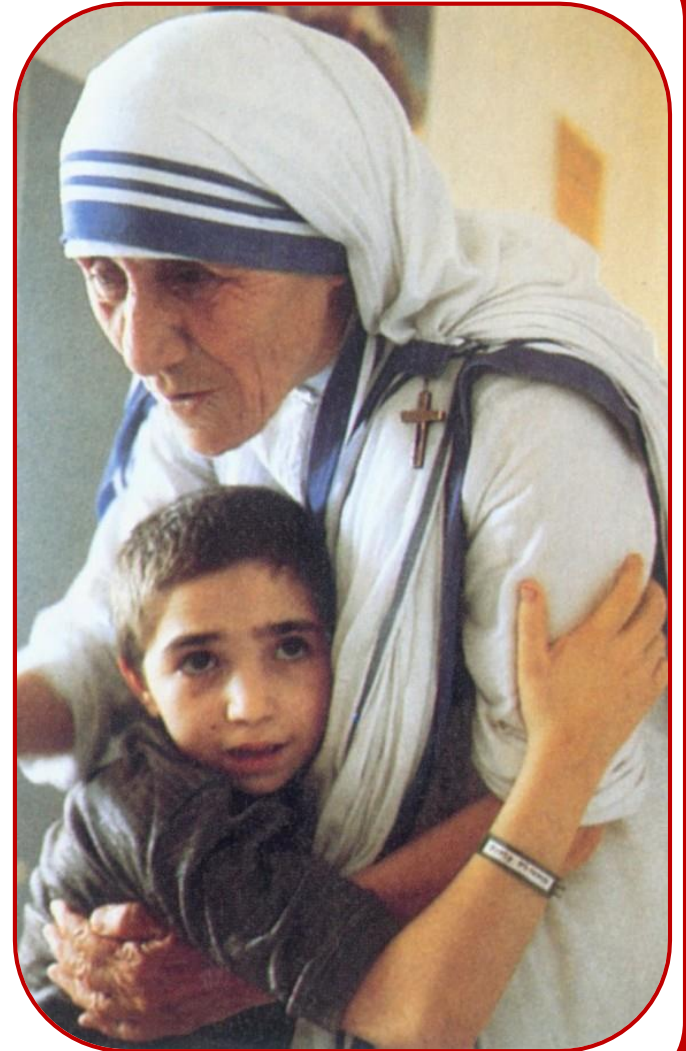
LET US SING
