



#### Jesus washed the feet of His disciples.





Jesus Fed the hungry




Jesus Cured the lepers

#### Sign of the Cross.


(Solemn form)


By the sign of the holy cross, protect us O Lord from our enemies. In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.




#### Just like Jesus loves, I will love all.

Dear Jesus, teach me to love everyone




### LET US SING
