Lesson 6

THE ANNUNCIATION





**A virgin named Mary lived in the town of Nazareth.
Her marriage was fixed with Joseph, a man from the tribe of
David.**

**One day an angel came to Mary. It was angel Gabriel.
Gabriel said to Mary "Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with you."
When Mary heard this, she was disturbed.**



The angel pacified her and said to Mary: Do not be afraid, you have won God's favour. You are to conceive and bear a son and you must name him Jesus. He will be great and will be called "Son of the Most High" (Lk 1.30-32).



When Mary heard this she said: "Behold the handmaid of the Lord. Be it done unto me according to your word" (Lk 2 : 38). Then the angel disappeared.



Don't you remember the promise of our loving God to Adam and Eve? God had promised that, He will send a saviour to save mankind from sin. It is this announcement about the coming of the saviour, that is the happy message the angel Gabriel announced to Mary.



The annunciation that our saviour Jesus will be born as the son of Mary is the **'Good News'** **'Mangalavartha'**

Do you know how Mary received this Good News?
Mary accepted it by surrendering herself to God's will, saying:

**"Behold the handmaid of the Lord.
Be it done unto me according to Thy word".**



She gave her consent to God's will. Thus Mary became the Mother of Jesus, the Saviour of the whole humanity.

Angelus Prayer

The Angel of the Lord declared to Mary: And she conceived of the Holy Spirit. **Hail Mary . . .**

Behold the handmaid of the Lord: Be it done unto me according to Thy word. **Hail Mary . . .**

And the Word was made Flesh: And dwelt among us. **Hail Mary . . .**

Pray for us, O Holy Mother of God:
that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.

Pour forth, we beseech Thee, O Lord, Thy grace into our hearts; that we, to whom the incarnation of Christ, Thy Son, was made known by the message of an angel, may by His Passion and Cross be brought to the glory of His Resurrection, through the same Christ Our Lord. **Amen.**
