

THE STAR IN THE EAST









They approached Herod, the King of Judea, and asked him: Where is the King of Jews born? We saw His star in the East and have come to adore Him." (Mt. 2:1-2)
















According to the instruction of the angels, the wise men returned without going back to Herod. King Herod knew he had been tricked by the wise men.

When Herod died the angel again appeared to Joseph in a dream. The angel asked him to come back to the land of Israel along with Mary and child. He did so.




They went to Nazareth and stayed there.

Jesus, the Nazarene, the king of the Jews.


LET US SING

The poorest child can bring.








O God, who led the humble shepherds and the wise men to the presence of the child Jesus, we praise you.
