





JOSEPH'S DREAM


"There we were binding sheaves in the field. Suddenly my sheaf rose and stood uprights; then your sheaves gathered around it and bowed down to my Sheaf".

His brothers felt all the more jealous of him.




Joseph's brothers hated him because of his dreams and his words.




JOSEPH IN EGYPT




The traders sold Joseph to the Potiphar, an officer of Pharaoh and captain of the guard. Lord God was with Joseph and so he excelled in all that he did.

In jail he interpret the dream of Pharaoh's chief cook and his cupbearer. His interpretation was proved correct soon after.






Meanwhile Joseph got married and had two son; - Manasseh & Ebraim.




God of your father will help you and bless you with the blessings of heaven above. (Genesis 49:25).
